We continue to bring in new members annually. This is important to the pool as families mature and the pool is no longer of interest to them. This year, we are introducing reduced "Senior Memberships" for members 55 years and older. A Senior Membership is defined as "Adult over 55, single, with spouse or significant other over 55. Members must reside in same residence. Children and grandchildren (not currently members of the pool) of senior members will be required to pay the \$5 guest fee upon entering the pool. Membership dues will be \$195 annually for a senior membership, \$260 annually for a family membership or \$195 for individual adult memberships. Maintenance fees will be \$60 annually. We will continue to offer a one-year trial membership for \$310 for your friends and family that are considering joining a pool.

We continue to look to you for support as we grow our membership. Keep in mind that we offer a "Finder's Fee" to our current members that recruit new full members. Please send your payments for dues, maintenance fees and the family census form to: Rockbrook Pool c/o Bonnie York, 6211 S 109th Avenue Circle, Omaha, NE 68137. Checks and forms must be postmarked by May 15th. Any payments postmarked after May 15th will be assessed a \$25 late fee. If your dues are unpaid, members will forfeit their bond after July 15th. If you wish to relinquish your bond, please notify Bonnie in writing by May 31, 2011. Bond relinquishments are accepted only by the Financial Secretary. If you do not provide notification by May 31 of your intent to relinquish your bond, you will be responsible for the current year's dues and maintenance fees.
